

# WELCOME TO OUR SHOW!

We want to offer everyone the opportunity to participate as safely as possible. Please respect this by carefully reading and following the instructions below. Our staff is happy to provide additional information on all arrangements before and throughout the show.

## Special instructions for exhibitors

Due to the COVID 19, our show is closed to the public and **we only allow one adult per cat** to enter the show venue. Our show is Drive In and we ask you to come only shortly before your cat's judging time and to spend as little time as possible inside the hall.

Exhibitors and staff should ensure that they are healthy and asymptomatic. Hygiene guidelines must be followed and safety distances must be maintained at all times. Premises are cleaned and disinfected regularly during the day.

ERY-SYD collects the names and telephone numbers of exhibitors entering the hall for the authorities in case of possible coronavirus exposures. The information will be treated confidentially, and the list will be destroyed two weeks after the show

Please note that we do not accept cash at the show. Payments, such as rosettes, can be paid by card.

## Checking in

- Check-in is open on Friday from 5 pm to 7 pm and on weekend from 9:30 until the last judging time announced in the schedule. If you check-in in advance, you can arrive at the show just before your cat's judging time. If you wish not to check in in advance, you can also check-in on arrival.
- Your cat does not need to be present when checking in, but please remember to bring cat's vaccination certificate. At the check-in, you will receive a participation ticket which you need when entering the show hall.

## Arriving at the show

- Judging times can be found in the judging table based on the EMS code and competition number. You can find your cat's competition number in the confirmation letter. The judging schedule includes also BIV and nominations, so it is easy to check when these selections are starting. Please note that sometimes judges may be behind schedule, but will never start judging before the scheduled time.
- Access to the hall is through the doors on the racetrack side (see picture below). Cats are brought into the hall and leave the hall only using their own judge's door to avoid extra exposures.
- Exhibitors are allowed enter the show hall not sooner than 20 minutes before the scheduled judging time.
- All exhibitors are required to use face masks inside the show hall. ERY-SYD offers one mask per day at the check-in point. Using your own mask is allowed.

## During the show

- Next to each judge is a secretary from whom you will receive the diploma immediately after the judging.
- Cats are asked to leave immediately when their competition is over. If you have two cats, both can be present until the competition for both cats is over for the day.
- If your cat is staying for BIV, nominations, or panel, your cat may stay in the hall using the cage area on the ground floor or in its own carrier or Sturdi cage in the seating area on the third floor. Cats are also allowed to wait outside the hall, for example in a car, at home, or at a hotel.
- Please remember safety distances when using cages and placing Sturdies and please leave an empty space between the cages. Unfortunately, own cages or other belongings cannot be left in the show hall overnight.

#### **Arriving to the show**

- Judging times can be found in the judging table based on the EMS code and competition number. You can find your cat's competition number in the confirmation letter. All judging schedules including BIV and nominations can be found. You will also find times for comparisons in the judging schedule (Best of Color and Best of Judge), so if your cat can advance, it is easy to check when these choices start from the schedule. Please note that sometimes judges may be behind schedule, but will never start judging before the scheduled time.
- Access to the hall is through the doors on the racetrack side (see picture below). Cats are brought into the hall and leave the hall only using their own judge's door to avoid extra exposures.
- Exhibitors are allowed to enter the show hall 20 minutes before cat's judging time.
- All exhibitors are required to use face masks inside the show hall. ERY-SYD on offers one mask per day at the check-in point. Using own mask is allowed.

#### **During the exhibition**

- Next to each judge is a secretary from whom you will receive the diploma immediately after the judging.
- Cats are asked to leave immediately when their own competition is over. If the owner has two cats, both can be present until the competition for both cats is over for the day.
- If your cat is staying for BIV, nominations or panel, your cat may stay in the hall using cage area on the ground floor or in its own carrier or Sturdi cage in the seating area on the third floor. Cats are also allowed to wait outside the hall, for example in a car, at home or at hotel.
- Please remember safety distances when using cages and placing Sturdies and please leave an empty space between the cages. Unfortunately, own cages or other belongings cannot be left in the show hall overnight.
